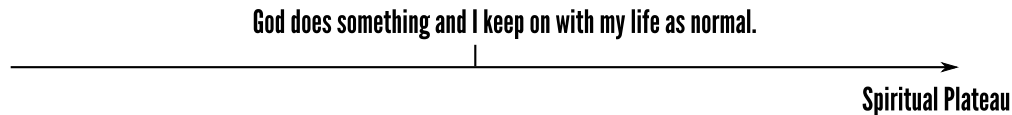
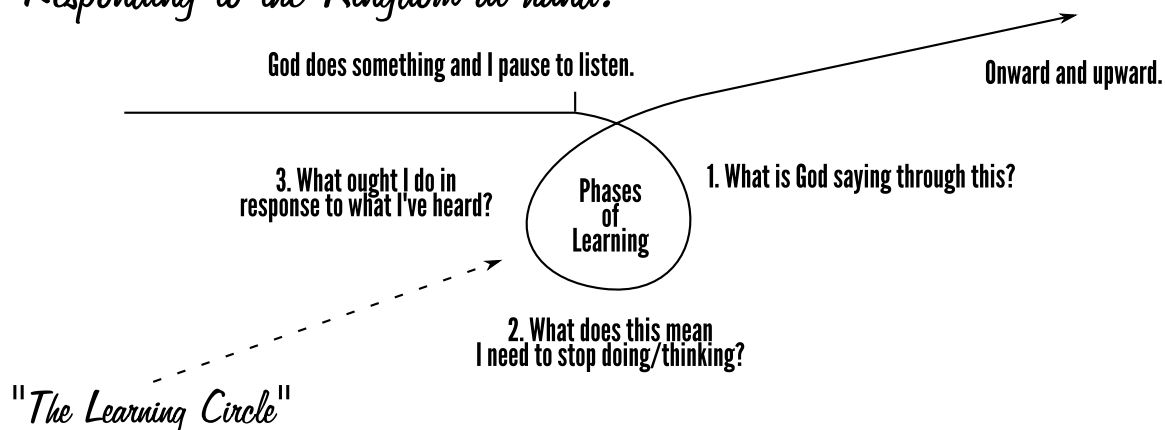


Letting the Kingdom Break In.

Have you had a "kingdom moment" this week?

Jesus tells us that the Kingdom of God is at hand and that we must repent. Heeding Christ requires us to look for and listen to those moments when the in-breaking of God's Kingdom touches our life. This may be in small ways, as you are nudged by God's Spirit in your daily habits, or in big ways, as God allows your plans to be changed and interrupted. The Kingdom is at hand: these moments are happening every day. Will you notice them, repent and enter in more deeply to the life of Jesus?

Sample questions to ask in discipling groups:

Where have you sensed God at work in your week? Where have you felt God's Spirit nudging your heart recently? What moments, this week, do you sense might have had a greater spiritual significance? When have you felt a tension between the values of this world and the values of heaven this past week?

The answers to any of these questions are an opportunity to enter "The Learning Circle" and be drawn deeper into the life of Christ.
